I believe in the Holy Ghost: The holy Catholic Church; The Communion of Saints: The Forgiveness of sins: The Resurrection of the body: And the Life everlasting. Amen."*

The Nicene Creed: *"I BELIEVE in one God the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, And of all things visible and invisible: And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God; Begotten of his Father before all worlds, God of God, Light of Light, Very God of very God; Begotten, not made; Being of one substance with the Father; By whom all things were made: Who for us men and for our salvation came down from heaven, And was incarnate by the Holy Ghost of the Virgin Mary, And was made man: And was crucified also for us under Pontius Pilate; He suffered and was buried: And the third day he rose again according to the Scriptures: And ascended into heaven, And sitteth on the right hand of the Father: And he shall come again, with glory, to judge both the quick and the dead; Whose kingdom shall have no end. And I believe in the Holy Ghost, The Lord, and Giver of Life, Who proceedeth from the Father and the Son; Who with the Father and the Son together is worshipped and glorified; Who spake by the Prophets: And I believe one Holy Catholic and Apostolic Church: I acknowledge one Baptism for the remission of sins: And I look for the Resurrection of the dead: And the Life of the world to come. Amen."*

Christian discipleship is central to St. Dunstan's Academy. Describe your family's religious life (church attendance, devotional practices, Bible-reading habit) as well as that of your son.

St. Dunstan's Academy offers an intense and challenging program, physically, spiritually, and academically. Does your son have any special needs; learning difficulties, differences, or disorders; medical concerns; mental health diagnoses; diagnosed behavioral disorders; allergies; or other relevant medical history?

The Code of Conduct at St. Dunstan's Academy is 1 Corinthians 16:13-14: "Watch ye, stand fast in the faith, quit you like men, be strong. Let all your things be done with charity." In keeping with these principles, students commit not to lie, cheat, steal, or evade personal responsibility. Students also commit to abstain from all illegal drugs including marijuana, tobacco, and alcohol and to abstain from owning, possessing, or looking at all pornography and pornographic materials. Has your son exhibited habitual difficulties with any of these temptations?

Digital pornography in particular has become a snare to many contemporary young men. Chastity will be part of our conversations around character formation at St. Dunstan's. Have you begun to have conversations with your son about pornography?

Given the physical, emotional, and academic demands of the program, our students need to have the capacity for self-control. Does your son have difficulty with emotional self-regulation (i.e. chronic anger, verbal outbursts, physical violence)? If so, describe in detail.
